
K-3 ON THE MOVE!!!

Welcome Back! Check out what's been happening!

- 2nd Data Collection: one-on-one administration of the Acadience Assessment that measures the early literacy skills specific to each grade level; an intermittent assessment conducted 3 times a year. Fa'afetai to all the large school administrators who teamed up with DCI -ELA & OASIS, and small schools that administered on their own-taking the initiative! Teamwork!
- Acadience Data Entry: DCI-ELA and OASIS completed task by Feb10. All 23 schools (Administrators & Teachers) and District leaders have access to view data results online.
- Side-By-Side Coaching (SBS): February 13-28 in all 19 schools on Tutuila; DCI-ELA & OASIS provided this critical teacher support. What does SBS look like? Teams of 2 observe Read Well or Language for Learning Programs, immediately step in when instructional procedure is incorrect, models correctly, then steps out and allows teacher to continue instruction using the appropriate procedure. Teaching moment right on the spot!
 - OASIS classroom visitations: monitor implementation of programs, use of materials, supplies and equipment to support student instruction, teacher aide support, organization of materials and student engagement.
