




THS VEX ROBOTIC LIVE TOURNAMENT

JROTC Live Remote Skills Event allows JROTC teams from all branches to compete for a spot at the VEX Worlds in Dallas, Texas. This event requires the competing teams to go live using a webcam on a Google Meet site provided by the REC Foundation, which hosts the event. Upon entering the live room, the host will place the teams in the competition room, where a referee will inspect their robot and the competition field. Upon a successful inspection, the skills competition will proceed and consist of the best out of 3 for the driver portion and the best out of 3 for the autonomous portion. This season's game is called High Stakes, where teams try and get as many rings into a stake in a 60-second time limit. The team that can score the most wins. In the Live Remote Skills event, 6 teams competed from across the country: Alabama, Texas, California, Kansas, and last but not least, American Samoa. Team 21111A had the second-highest score of the evening, with 47. Team A did 33 on their driver attempt and 14 on their auton attempt.
